Single Family Residence Tree Alert



If you have street trees that were planted by D.R. Horton, you'll want to treat them now with a Systemic Insecticide to prevent the sticky gooey substance that drips on sidewalks and cars. It is produced by aphids that live in certain trees and drop "honey-dew" in spring and summer. Systemic insecticide is available at any Garden Center and is easily applied to the tree's root base, no spraying required.



RAT SIGHTING

A concerned single family homeowner attended the March Board Meeting to report that she witnessed a large rat run across her backyard in the predawn hours. She called Beaverton Vector Control, who sent someone out. The officer advises that all areas should be kept clear of piles of yard debris and trash, all possible entry holes around drains, vents, and in walls should be plugged, and residents should check under decks and around the house foundation for nests or signs of intrusion. He also advised her that, in addition to pet and wild critter food, rats will eat dog waste. Please do your part to discourage rat intrusion. Keep your yard clean and, if you find signs that rats are moving in, call a pest control company for help.
