LAWN CARE HINT FOR DETACHED HOMES

The landscapers who care for our common areas and the townhouse front yards aerated lawns this past week. You might want to do the same. Aeration allows water and nutrients to reach grass roots. Make sure the ground is moist. The day after a rain shower or thorough watering is best. Use an aerator to perforate the soil with small holes. You can buy or rent an aerator at a garden store or home improvement center.
